The University at Albany Police Department is happy to present the Basic Law Enforcement Bicycle Patrol Course to be held Monday through Friday, June 3rd– June 7th, 2019 at the University at Albany Uptown Campus.

COST: \$200.00 per student, which includes student manual, all instruction, liquids on the course, and lunch and breakfast for 4 days.

WHAT TO BRING:

- Department issued police bike (headlight, taillight, horn/bell, rear mounted kick stand, toe clips)
- Eyewear (tinted and clear)
- Helmet (Mandatory)
- Duty Uniform w/full duty belt (Thursday we will be in full uniform)
- Gloves
- Water Bottles (at least 2 if possible)
- Rain Gear (we ride rain or shine)
- 100 Rounds of duty ammo
- Tire levers, chain tool, frame pump or CO2, tube patch kit (not mandatory, but nice to have)

This is a 40 hour course designed to train officers how to safely and effectively use a bicycle in the performance of their patrol duties. The course includes classroom and on-bike instruction including basic bike handling skills, negotiating obstacles, performing high-speed dismounts, suspect apprehension, and live fire exercises. Bike patrol officers should be physically fit and prepared to perform the necessary physical activity. Lodging may be available at an additional cost.
